Subject:- **Disposal of representations from the candidates not eligible to compete for counselling against the seats notified vide Notification No. 108-BOPEE of 2019 dated 21-10-2019 -**

**Notice No. 107-BOPEE of 2019**

**Dated 30-10-2019**

Consequent upon issuance of Notification No. 108-BOPEE of 2019 dated 21-10-2019, vide which the unfilled seats available due to increase in intake capacity of three Government Medical Colleges and two Government Dental Colleges of the state were notified and procedure laid down for filling up of the same, Board also issued certain clarifications as sought by the candidates who have been allotted MBBS seats in the Government colleges under OM and are not eligible to compete under EWS quota for purposes of upgradation, vide Notice No. 106-BOPEE of 2019 dated 26-10-2019. While doing so the Board also gave an opportunity to such candidates to make representations, if any, if they chose to do so along with documentary evidence in support of their claim.

Instead of making any formal representation, some candidates, who have already been allotted MBBS seats in Government Colleges in the OM category, again approached the Board for according consideration for upgradation on the basis of EWS quota for MBBS. The candidates were again explained the procedure and process. Despite having done so, some candidates approached the Press and the Media in this regard to further pressurise the Board to modify the criteria/eligibility which under no circumstances is possible as such candidates are not eligible to participate in the upgradation, which only can deprive the EWS candidates who have not been allotted any seat in MBBS of their genuine rights.

Board has also received some requests from the candidates to clarify as to whether the candidates who had produced EWS certificates at the time of registration but were treated as OM candidate as the rules for filling up of the additional seats were not notified by the Government then, shall be eligible to compete against the EWS quota seats in case they have not been allotted any seat in OM.

Having taken cognizance of the same and for ensuring transparency in the systems it is hereby reiterated that the detailed procedures with the eligibility criteria have been laid down vide Notification No. 108-BOPEE of 2019 dated 21-10-2019 read with Notice No. 106-BOPEE of 2019 dated 26-10-2019 and as such no further clarification is required on this count.

However, representation made by a candidate bearing NEET Roll No.250281147 has been examined. He was treated as an OM candidate and is now in possession of valid EWS certificate and has not availed any benefit under OM but his request for change of category to JKPM cannot be accepted as the Board had while notifying the State Merit List vide Notification No. 54-BOPEE of 2019 dated 25-06-2019 already given two days time to candidates to represent against the positions assigned to them in the State Merit List but he had chosen not to represent or apply under JKPM as he had not applied under JKPM. The cut off date of eligibility was 24-06-2019 and he failed to produce or upload the certificate at the time of registration. He has also repeatedly informed the Board through the e-mails that he fell in the EWS categories. He shall be eligible to compete under EWS quota if otherwise eligible. Therefore, the representation is disposed off accordingly.
