S.O. 277 -In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Act, 2004, the Lieutenant Governor of Jammu and Kashmir hereby directs that the following amendments shall be made in the Jammu and Kashmir Reservation Rules, 2015: namely:-

I. In rule 14, at the end, the following explanation shall be added, namely:-

"Explanation: the reservation to children of Defence personnel under this rule shall be governed by inter-se-priority as may be notified by the Department of Ex. Servicemen Welfare, Ministry of Defence, Government of India from time to time."

II. In rule 15, at the end, the following explanation shall be added, namely:-

"Explanation: the reservation to children of Defence personnel under this rule shall be governed by inter-se-priority as may be notified by the Department of Ex. Servicemen Welfare, Ministry of Defence, Government of India from time to time."







**INTER-SE PRIORITY FOR RESERVATION/PREFERENCE TO THE WARDS
OF ARMED FORCES PERSONNEL BY STATES/UTS FOR ADMISSION TO
MEDICAL/PROFESSIONAL/NON PROFESSIONAL COURSES**

Sir,

1. Department of Ex Servicemen Welfare, Govt of India, Ministry of Defence vide their letter No F.No 6(I)/2017/D(Res II) dt 21 May 2018 has laid down priority for reservation/preference to the wards of Armed Forces personnel by states/UTs, for admission to Medical/Professional/Non Professional Courses (**Enclosure-1**). However it was experienced by Sh Kanwal Krishen Koul, Husband of Late Lt Col (Mrs) Lady Gangoo, (MNS) (Physical Casualty – Attributable to Military Service) that the form being issued by JK BOPEE does not give reservation norms correctly, as all category of Ex-servicemen/Serving Soldier with Gallantry Awards/Disabilities have been clubbed together (**Application attached as Enclosure-2**). However, your department has already directed departments/institutions for implementation the reservation as per MoD guidelines (**refer to Enclosure-1 above**) vide your letter No HE/Gen/Spl.Prov/2017/736 dated 18 Jul 2018 (**Enclosure-3**).


2. A copy of the Annexure XI of the JK BOPEE prospectus for admission of Defence Personnel Wards is enclosed, for your reference please (**Enclosure-4**). Already, it is noticed that other institutions like Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University Delhi has amended their rules as per guidelines given by MoD. One sample Application Form is enclosed for reference please (**Enclosure-5**).

3. The same case has already been forwarded to The Principle Secretary to Govt, Higher Education Deptt, Civil Sectt (UT) Jammu vide our letter No 536/ADM/DSW/5102-12 dated 25 Jan 2020 (**Enclosure-6**). However, it has been informed that the case is to be processed by Social Welfare Deptt.

4. It is requested that the priority laid down by Ministry of Defence be implemented by JKBOPEE and all Educational Institution in letter and spirit, as non adherence to guidelines may lead to legal complications.

5. The above is submitted for necessary amendments and passing suitable instructions on prioritization of merit of children under CDP, strictly as per the norms legislated by MoD please (**refer to Enclosure-1 above**).
